

Search Tools

- Find
 - Takes at least TWO segments
 - The first arguments is the directory you want to look inside
 - The second argument is what you are looking for in a file system
 - Find has so many options for finding based on size, name and more.
- Locate
 - Works similar to 'find'.
 - Is generally the first command.
 - Uses a database/ cache to quickly store where a file is located
 - It is important to use the 'updatedb' command often if you use locate so your database is up to date
- Which
 - Takes another command as an argument and will tell you where the binary for that command lives in the file system.
