At - eg. At 7 o clock, At this moment, At noon, at midnight

In - eq. In 1980, in Feb, in third week, in morning, in eve, in afternoon

On - eg. On Monday, on this day, on birthday

By - eq. By 3 o clock, by Friday, by next day

Since - eg. I've waited here since 5 o clock, since thursday, since 2000

For - eg. for 5 minutes, for three days, for a week, for long, for a week

From - eq. I was in Calcutta from 1993

**About -** I'll see you in about 4 days, it took about 4 hours to reach there.

Over - eg. There is a calender over the table

In - eg. There is A meeting in the land of the land of

Into - eg. He was stord!

Among - eq. He was standing among the trees

At - eg. I shall meet you at the Railway Station

**Under -** eq. There is box under the table

**Beneath -** eg. The ship sank beneath the waves

Underneath - eg. The letter was pushed Underneath the door

## **Prepositions Of Direction**

For - eg. They left for Mumbai

At - eg. Why are you staring at me?

To - eg. He went to school as usual

Towards - eq. They went towards the scene of the accident

From - eq. He returned from school

Off - eq. He hit wide off the mark

Out of - eg. He came out of the room
