carboxyhemoglobin (i.e. CO) (v) Can cause green house effect (too much CO in atmosphere) (vi) Dust and smoke can cause asthma.

(vii) Lead poisoning can affect children's intelligence quotient (I.Q.) (viii) Nitrogen oxides irritate the lungs.

Control of air pollution

- (i) Industries should be sited away from residential areas.
- (ii) Tall factory chimneys should be just built.
 (iii) Passing of wastes throughs filters and absorberge
- (iv) The use of lead-fuels fuels.
- (v) Banning of old cars.
- 2. Water pollution: Fresh water is polluted through the discharge of sewage and other wastes from farms and at times from industries. Marine pollution is mostly caused by oil spillage, industrial wastes and agricultural wastes.

Effects of water pollution

- (i) Efforts should be made on recycling wastes.
- (ii) People should be educated on the result of land pollution.
- (iii) Incessant dumping of refuse should be discouraged.
- (iv) The government should have a policy on land protection.
- (v) Refuse should be incinerated.
