reasons for the decline:

- The birth rate in Mexico has fallen steadily since at least 1990 and now stands at 2.2 children per woman. Fewer people coming into the workforce.
- Data from the U.S. Border Patrol show a drop of more than 50 percent since 2009. It used to be border agents stopped over half a million people coming in from Mexico. Last year, it was about 230,000.
- More surveillance, stiffer penalties and more barriers at the border have had the intended effect.
- Child separation
