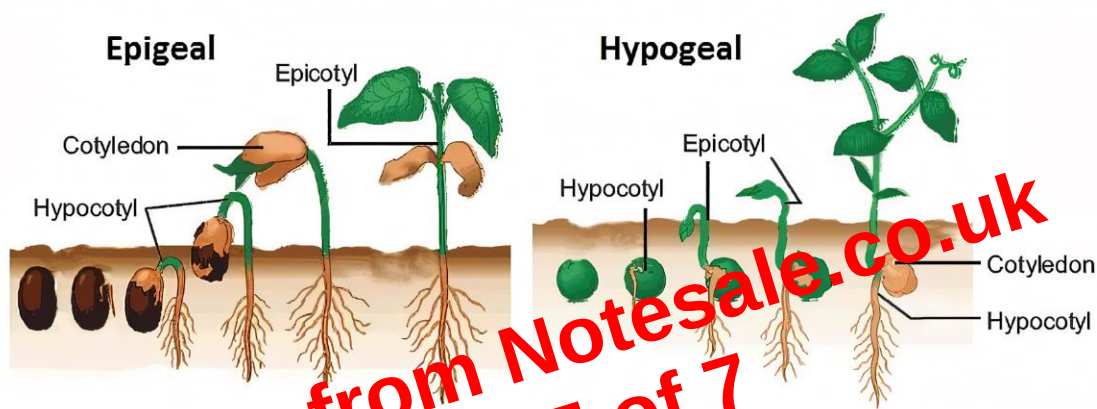


examples of seeds that germinate this way. In **hypogeal** germination, the epicotyl elongates and forms the hook. In these types of germination, the cotyledons stay underground. Pea, maize and coconut germinate this way.



Conditions for Seeds Germination:

Seeds germination depends on both internal and external conditions. The internal and external conditions include a live embryo and sufficient food storage. The most important external conditions include water, oxygen and favorable temperatures.
