Premolars (8): For crushing and grinding


Molar (12): For crushing, grinding and masticating food.

- 1. Appendix
- 2. Caecum
- 3. Colon (ascending, transverse descending and sigmoid)
- 4. Rectum

- Length: Approx. 1.5 m
- Width: 7.5 cm
