

● Serosa :

outermost layer

→ Made up :

1. Thin mesothelium
2. Connective tissue

● Muscularis :

- Outer longitudinal
- Inner circular muscle fibres

» **An oblique muscle layer : present in some region.**

➤ Compound :

1. Exocrine → secretes
an alkaline pancreatic
juice

- **Containing** → Enzymes

2. Endocrine → secretes

- Hormones
- Insulin
- Glucagon

❏ **Situated :** Between limbs of c- shaped duodenum

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Gastric glands have 3 major types of cells namely

1. Mucus neck (secrets mucus)
2. Paptic or chief cells (secrets proenzyme pepsinogen)
3. Parietal or oxyntic cells (secrets HCL and intrinsic factor → absorption of vitamin B12)
