- emission are from residential and commercial users primarily from heating and electricity use.
- 5. **Agricultural practices** must be improved to use fewer fertilizers, less industrial production of beef, and better sustainable agricultural practices such as sustainable crop rotation and reduced tilling of the soil (which releases carbon). 9% of greenhouse gas emissions were from agriculture.
- 6. Land Use and Forestry cutting down trees not only releases the carbon stored in that tree and in the soil, but also prevents that tree from taking carbon dioxide out of the atmosphere during the course of its life. Sustainable forestry and land use lead to carbon dioxide being taken out of the atmosphere.

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
