
Epidermis...



- The stratum germinativum (jer mah nah Tīlyrem) is composed of several layers of living cells capable of cell division.
 - It is the innermost layer of the epidermis, and contains melanin... the pigment that gives color to the skin.
 - The more abundant the melanin... the darker the skin color.

Hypodermis

- The subcutamedus tissue or hypodermis is composed of adipose and connective tissue. It supports, nourishes, insulates, and cushions the skin.
- The dermis is connected to underlying tissue by the subcutaneous tissue.
