

FUTURE CONTINUOUS

When?

- When an action will be going on at a certain time in the future.

Examples:

- At this time tomorrow I'll be sitting on a plane and I'll be flying to Spain.
- What will students be learning at school in 50 years' time?

FUTURE PERFECT

When?

- When something will be finished in the future.

Examples:

- Next week we will have been together for 30 years.
- I'll have been working for my company for 20 years next month.
- Will you have finished the text by Friday?
