

* Associations




Make an attempt to relate the theory you read to events, sengt of people. This makes them easier to remember. This is yout refer to as "memory links." You will remember new information better if you associate it with something you are new information.

Some people enjoy moving through a house using associations. A word you want to remember is associated with an object that begins with the same letter as the word in each room of the house.

One example of this is the decimals of the number π =3.14159265359...
