The molecules or the nutrient will move easily from the village to the blood vessels because of those small finger-like projections which are called "willis." The last step of course is the urine collection. All these tubules will secrete out

In the urine, the blood will not be going out. It will be the fluid it has the urea and water right. The blood is not coming enough in urine, basically, very good. Yes, it is a nitrogenous waste.
