Molecules transported	Large solid particles	Extracellular fluid	Specific molecules
Description	Pseudopodia extend outwards from the cell to enclose the solid particles Vesicles formed usually fuse with lysosomes containing hydrolytic enzymes to digest these macromolecules	Droplets of extracellular fluid are incorporated into small vesicles	Coated pits form vesicles when specific molecules bind to receptor proteins on cell surface Coated pits are reinforced by clathrin Selective form of endocytosis allows cells to take up specific molecules
