Napolean

- Ruled France from 1799 to 1815.
- Gained absolute powers in 1799 by becoming the First Consul.

Civil Code of 1804 / Napoleonic Code:

- Equality before the law was established
- Secured the right to property
- Simplified administrative measures
- Abolished feudal system
- Freed peasants from serfdom and manorial dues
- Guild restrictions were removed

Napoleon took away political freedom, increased taxes, implied consorship and forced people to join French army.
