Step 3:- Take the square of the number in the ten's place.

1^2=1

Now, write these numbers from right to left. The answer is 196.

• Take another example, say, 29,

Step 1:-9^2=81

Take 1 and keep 8.

Step 2:-2(2\*9) = 36

Now, add 4 to it. It is 8 from Notes ale. Co. uk

## Squares of three-digit numbers

This is calculated in the same way as explained above. Let us explain this with few examples.

Square of 106 :

Step 1:-6^2=36

Take 6 and keep 3.

Step 2:- Here, we take the remaining digits, i.e., 10.

Multiply 10 and 6 and take double of it.
