At the recent Consumer Electronics Show (CES), BMW presented a concept car called The i Vision D that can make faces and even talk to you. French startup Sky Ted unveiled a mask that silences your voice to those around you, allowing for private phone calls in public places. A security drone that flies around your home while you're away, reminiscent of something out of a stealth video game, was also presented. For parents with deep pockets, a hands-free baby stroller with a 3,330 dollar price tag is now available.
