intestine. The reason why cellulose cannot be broken down and digested is because our body has not created the right type of enzymes that break down cellulose and roughage. The bile salts and emulsified fats are reabsorbed by the ileum.

7. Excretion: Rectum

Finally, what's left of the food is a solid called faces, therefore, its passed though the rectum by peristalsis; before it goes though the process of defecation; in which the faces is pushed out of the anus.
