$\hookrightarrow$  Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome

Correlations - HIV

Diseases may be correlated (linked) by having one disease you are more likely to get another.

- HIV damages the immune system (results in AIDS) and so you are more likely to catch other pathogens.
- A disease could damage your natural barriers to disease, so other pathogens can get in more easily.
- A disease could stop an organ system from working properly, making diseases more unlikely.
