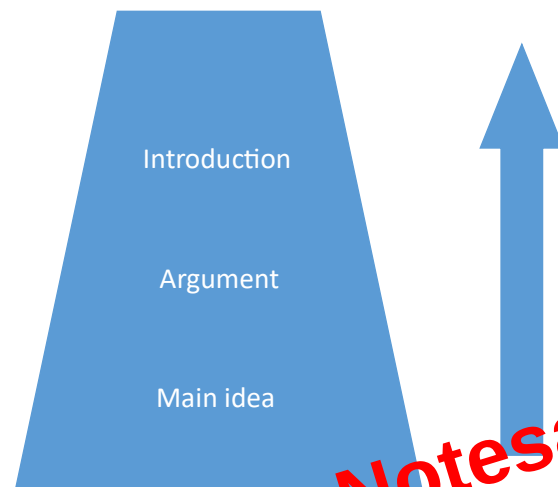


Writing Styles

Inductive Writing

- First develop the importance of a point writer wishes to make.
- General information based on individual perception and experiences.
- Main idea exposed at the end of paragraph.
- First argument then statement.
- Topic sentence comes in last as a conclusion of discussion above.

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Deductive Writing

- Main point of paragraph appears in the beginning.
- Specific details comes after main point to support it.
- Start with valid and scientific truth.
- Practice of reasoning and organizing information.
