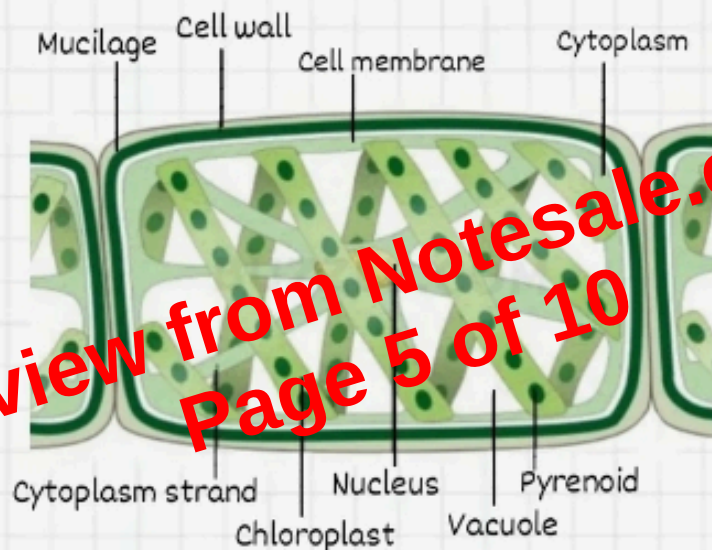


ALGAE

- Algae are plant like organisms are containing chlorophyll.
- The algae, which complete their life cycle in free-floating state, are known as phytoplankton.
- Algae grow in aquatic habitats and moist place. Algae may be unicellular or multicellular.
- Algae reproduce both by sexual or asexual methods.



FUNGI

- Fungi are saprophytic or parasitic.
- Fungi are plant like organism, which do not contain chlorophyll like mushroom, puffballs etc.
- Yeast and mould are two main groups of fungi.
- Yeast are unicellular, whereas mould are multicellular.
- Yeast may be aerobic or anaerobic respiration
