

## II. Before Writing a Science Article, you should ask:

1. Why should your readers care? What's in it for them?
2. Will it help them understand something better?  
Surprise them? Scare them? Make them laugh?
3. What would they want to know about? What do they already know?
4. What questions would they ask, given the chance?

## III. Rules in Writing Science Articles:

1. Understand the jargon.
2. Use concrete words where possible.
3. Do not overload with figures.
4. Write brightly.
5. Do not sensationalize.
6. Give background details.
7. Illustrate your story.
8. Acknowledge source.
