

ASPECTS OF VERBS

- Past
- Present Perfect
- Present
- Future

Past Aspect

- Indicates that the action is done
- It is also used with the suffixes **na**, **nag**, **um**, and **in**.

Present Perfect Aspect

- The action/task had just been completed
- In its formation the suffix **ka** is added and the **first syllable of the word is repeated**.

Present Aspect

- The action is currently happening or is continuing to happen.
- The suffixes **na**, **nag**, **um** and **in** are used.
- The **first syllable** of the root word must be **repeated**.

Future Aspect

- The action has not yet been done/is about to be done.
- It is used with the suffixes **ma** and **mag**.
- If the suffix "**um**" is used, it will be deleted.
- If the suffix "**in**" is used, it will be moved to the end of the word.
