3 Periods of Greek Literature History

- 1. Remote Antiquity Age of Herodotus
- This covers the Pre-Homeric & Homeric Age
- Includes the earliest poetry of Greece & the works of Homer
- 2. Age of Herodotus Death of Alexander the Great (323 BC)

- Coincides with the Athenian Period Golden Age of Pericles
 3. Period of Decline (to AD 1452)
 Extends from that eath of Alexander the Great to the enslavement of the Greeks
