The Crimean war 1854:

- Britain saw it as a preventative war to prevent a balance of power or Britain's dominance of the M
- Revolts in 1848 throughout Europe – worried ab Germany states, Italy. Aim to keep the existing t
- Worried about security of sea route to India and Ottoman Empire and Russia stepping into forme etc.
- Motivated by imperialism – Russia would have u and the near east if the Turkish empire fell. Didn Mediterranean – saw as indirect threat to naval
