Taxonomy: The science of classification.

Father of Taxonomy: Carolus Linnaeus.

Systematics: Organizing organisms based on evolutionary relationships.

Basis of Taxonomy: Characterization, Identification, Classification, Nomendature.

Nomenclature: Common names (local) and scientific names (international).

Binomial Nomenclature: Introduced by Carolus Linnaeus, two-part Latin naming system.

T**axonomic Categories**: Kingdom, Phyland Ciass, Order,

Family, Genus, Species Motes

Species; Carlo anit, character by morphological traits.

Genus: Group of related species.

Family: Group of related genera.

Order: Group of related or co-related families.

Class: Group of related orders.

Phylum: Group of animals sharing characteristics.

Kingdom: Animal or Plant Kingdom.

Remember the mnemonic "King Peter Choose One Fresh Green Spices" to recall the taxonomic categories.
