

named after the Virgin Queen^{four years} after her death in 1607.

The fourth feat of her era was taking proper administrative decisions which put the country and its people before anything else. The Queen Elizabeth, did not marry to ensure she solely could take proper decisions for her country all by herself. Rejecting King Philip II's approaches and the proposal of the King of France via King Philip II, she said "Beggars woman and single, far rather than queen and married or in other words" "I would rather be a beggar woman and single than a queen and married".

Her fifth feat was strengthening her country's military. She did so by making battle ships smaller and more manoeuvrable. She added cannons which could fire cannonballs further as compared to regular cannons and were easily reloadable. To man the ships, she trained the sea-people i.e. fishermen so they were used to the unpredictable nature of the sea. Due to trained people and manoeuvrable ships and new cannons, England was able to fend for itself when Philip II Spanish Armada of roughly 150 ships with 18,000 men attacked in 1588.
