Reaction with bases.

Acid react with insoluble base and alkalis to form salt and water as the only product. Such reactor is known as neutralization.

Reaction with trioxocarbonate(IV)

Acid react with trioxocarbonate(IV) to liberate carbon(IV)oxide.

Uses of acid
Hydrochloric acid is used to remove rust.
Boric acid is used as a mild antiseptic or germicide.
Tartaric acid is used in making baking soda.
Acetic acid is used in preserving food.
Fatty acid is used in the manufacture of soap, etc.
