Why would you want to use resource tagging with AWS? - ANSWER-To limit the amount of API calls being made to Amazon.

Which UEM deployment will OneAgent handle automatically? - ANSWER-JS Tag insertion.

How does UEM work? - ANSWER-JS code sends data about user session to Mission Control. This data can correlate page actions to form a user session linking each action to a specific user.

What is a user session in Dynatrace? - ANSWER-A group of user actions that are performed in a web application during a limited period of time. Cookies are used to group those actions into a session.

How long are service trace and code insights retained? (SaaS / Managed) - ANSWER-10 days / Configurable

How long are service requests and attributes retained? (SaaS / Managed) - ANSWER-35 days / Configurable

How long is non Aggregated user data retained? (SaaS / Maraget) - ONSWER-10 days / Configurable

What is the "--seed-ip <ip>" parameter used for? - ANSWER-Used when installing a secondary node. You specify the IP of the master node using this parameter.

What is the "--seed-auth <auth-token>" parameter use for? - ANSWER-Used when installing a secondary node. You specify a token from the master node, so that it knows that this installation is a secondary node.

(Linux) What features does Dynatrace OneAgent require root privileges for? - ANSWER-Access open sockets of each process, access list of libraries of each process, access name / executable path of each process, access command line arguments of each process, monitor network traffic, read application configuration files, parse executables for Go discover, and gather monitoring data related to Docker containers.

(Linux) What features does Log Analytics require root privileges for? - ANSWER-Accessing system logs: /var/log/syslog and /var/log/messages, accessing the list of open file handlers for each process (/proc file system), and accessing the log file for each process.

Does your Docker environment need to run in pitilised mode in order to install OneAgent? - ANSWER-It requires privileged mode.

What programming the larges are available to configure a Custom Service with? - ANSWER Load. NET, PHP, and (all eng (Go).

How can you define where Custom Services are traced? - ANSWER-Can define the entry-point of a method in a class or use an implemented interface.

What attributes uniquely define web request services (e.g. what is used to detect them)? - ANSWER-Web server name, context root, and web application ID.

What is the best way to keep an eye on the CPU usage of a host? - ANSWER-Dashboard it, in some type of fashion (e.g. Custom Chart).

What is the base end-point for making API requests on SaaS? - ANSWER-https://{your-environment-id}.live.dynatrace.com/api (NOTE THAT IT'S HTTPS AND NOT HTTP).

How does Dynatrace enforce an API limit on SaaS customers? - ANSWER-They limit the number of calls per second.

What is "Ready Time"? - ANSWER-Ready thre it is percentage of time that a virtual machine is ready, but can't be scheduled bruin on a physical CPU. (You want this below 10%.)

When deploying One Agent enter Columnities, why would the Hosts report as Kubernetes? - ANS VER-OpenShift is barically the UI for Kubernetes orchestration. In the end, it's still Kubernetes hosts.

What is the user session timeout? - ANSWER-30 minutes of inactivity.

What is the max number of user actions for a user session? - ANSWER-200

What type (not load, xhr, or custom) of user actions can cause bounces? - ANSWER-Entry actions.

Give some examples of services that we support out-of-the-box. - ANSWER-Java-based (Servlets, Jetty, etc.), Web-servers (Apache, Tomcat, NodeJs, etc.), Database-services (SQL, MongoDB, etc.).

What frameworks does Dynatrace support RUM auto-injection out-of-the-box? - ANSWER-Java, Apache HTTP Server, IIS, NGINX, and Node.js

What is the best way to keep track of error messages in logs? - ANSWER-Create an Error-type log event.
