

- An agreement is the result of the proposal made by one party to the other party and that other party gives his acceptance.
- Thereto,
Agreement= Proposal+ Acceptance

Enforceability by Law

- Enforceable means able to be imposed, can be executed and can be abide by the law.
- An agreement to become a contract must give rise to a legal obligation which means duty enforceable by law.

Conclusion

**Contract= Accepted Proposal
(Agreement)+ Enforceability by law**

All contracts are agreements but every not every agreement is a contract.

- In case of domestic, social and political agreements, law presumes that parties didn't have any intention to create legal relations
