The anterior triangle of the neck is divided into four triangles surrounded by boundaries.

- I. **S**ubmental Triangle
- II. **D**igastric Triangle
- III. **C**arotid Triangle
- IV. **M**uscular Triangle

For easy remembrance use this mnemonic "Sally's Dog Chased Mice."

CLINICAL RELEVANCE

Carotid pulsation

- Carotid bodies – important baroreceptors (sensors for changes in pressure)
- Carotid sinus hypersensitivity
- Ligation of external carotid artery
- surgical dissection of carotid Triangle
- Carotid occlusion and endarterectomy
