- 1. Myocarditis is inflammation of the myocardium with necrosis of cardiac myocytes.
- 2. Myocarditis occurs when the heart muscle (myocardium) becomes inflamed. Inflammation occurs when your body's immune system responds to infections.

- Acute Myocarditis: Acute myocarditis describes relatively recent or fast onset of myocarditis, and is usually caused by a viral infection
- Chronic Myocarditis: Chronic myocarditis is when it takes longer than usual to treat the disease.
- Lymphocytic Myocarditis: Lymphocytic myocarditis is a rare form of myocarditis that can result in hospitalization for acute care.
