DNA

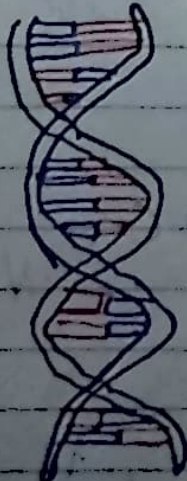
It carries the genetic materials (genes) that is transferred from a generation to another. These genes are responsible for:

RNA

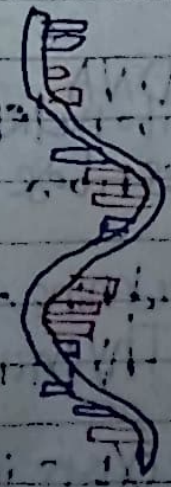
It is used in building the proteins which the cell needs.
