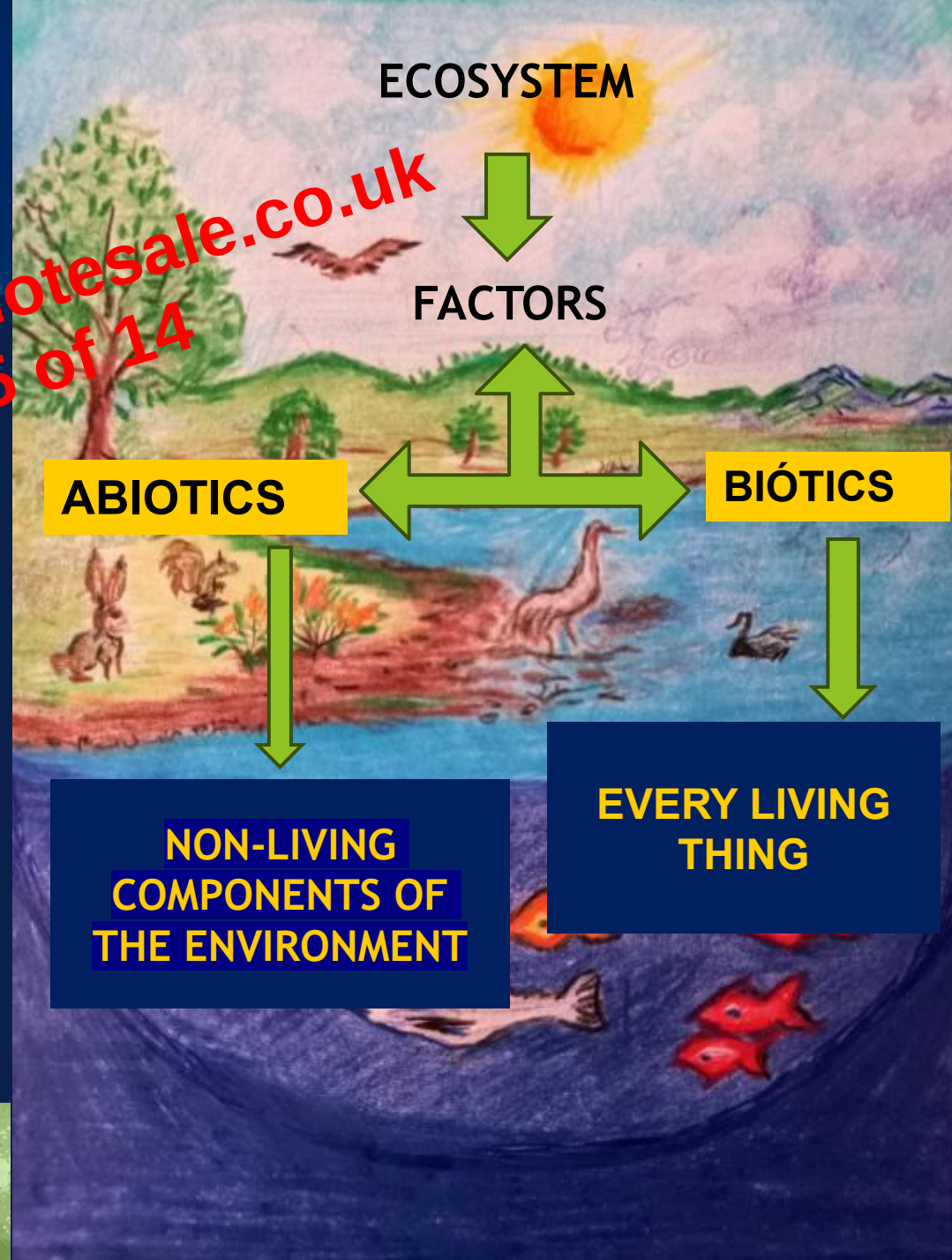


What is an ecosystem?

- Ecosystem is any area of the biosphere in which populations of a community (biotic factors) interact with each other and with the abiotic environment.
- In this interaction there is a flow of energy and a recycling of materials.



Definition of the levels of biological organisation



Ecosystem: It is the area in which populations of a community (biotic components) interact and coexist with each other and with abiotic components.



Biome: a group of individuals belonging to the same species that can reproduce with each other and coexist in space and time.



Biosphere: it is the layer of the earth's surface where living things live. It is made up of the lithosphere, hydrosphere and part of the atmosphere.
