Functions

Definition: A block of code designed to perform a particular task.

- Syntax:

```
Return_type function_name(parameters) {  
    // function body  
}
```

Pointers

Definition: Variables that store the memory address of another variable.

- Syntax: ``data_type pointer_name;`` (e.g., ``int ptr;``)
