- The use of **collective pronouns** (particularly in the emphatic first line) show how the islanders are close and that this is a shared and universal experience.
- Forceful sounds such as "Blast" are used to portray the violence of the storm and the strength of nature, whilst sibilant sounds (e.g. "Sink walls" and "squat") mirror the sound of the waves and "whistling" wind.
- After the volta of "But no", the descriptions of safety and security are contrasted with the violent imagery of the storm. This causes a shift in tone and creates a sense of drama and fear in the poem.
