

Some Useful Keyboard Shortcuts for Browser

Keyboard shortcuts are keystroke combinations that are used for the quick access to browser features. We can save lots of time by using keyboard shortcuts. They are not only used for browsers but also with applications such as Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint etc...We can simply use the keyboard shortcuts by pressing the keys as said in the list.

Check out the list for shortcuts:

1. To copy highlighted text : CTRL + C
2. To cut highlighted text : CTRL + X
3. To paste copied or cut text : CTRL + V
4. To open a new tab : CTRL + T
5. To close a tab : CTRL + W
6. To open the print dialogue box : CTRL + P
7. To open the find dialogue box : CTRL + F
8. To find the next match of the searched text on the page : CTRL + G
9. To find the previous match of the searched text on the page : CTRL + Shift + G
10. To zoom a web page : CTRL + +
11. To zoom out a web page : CTRL + -
12. To go to default zoom level : CTRL + 0
13. To open the recently closed tabs: CTRL + Shift + T
14. To reload the current page : CTRL + R (F5 also works)
15. To open new window : CTRL + N
16. To open new incognito window: CTRL + Shift + N
17. To open downloads : CTRL + J
18. To clear browsing data : CTRL + Shift + Del
19. To bookmark a tab : CTRL + D
20. To bookmark all tabs : CTRL + Shift + D
21. To hide bookmarks bar : CTRL + Shift + B
22. To open bookmarks manager : CTRL + Shift + O
23. To save a page : CTRL + S
24. To open task manager : Shift + Esc
25. To open developer tools : CTRL + Shift + I
26. To report an issue : Alt + Shift + I
27. Switching to the specified tab : CTRL + 1 – 8 (Change the tab number accordingly i.e., to go to first tab CTRL + 1, to second tab CTRL + 2 likewise.)
28. To switch to the last tab : CTRL + 9
