- -> Central problems of economics
- A) What to produce: The first central problem encountered by the economy is to decide which goods and services are to be produced and in what quantity. A country has to decide whether to produce luxury goods or necessary goods, capital goods or consumer goods as all the goods cannot be produced in desired quantities

This problem has two dimensions:

- Kinds of goods to be produced
- Quantity of goods to be produced
- B) How to produce: It is the problems that are related to what technique is to be used for CO producing various goods and Sovices. An economy carrefly be from among the given

- Labour : intensive technique

- Capital: intensive technique
- C) For whom to produce: It is a problem concerning the distribution of goods and services among factors of production in economy
- This central problem has two dimensions
- = Personal distribution of income(among factors of production)
- = Functional distribution of income(within the factors)
