The brain of cell Double membranous organelle

Location

In animal cell, present in the center In plant cell, present in the periphery of cell due to presence of a large vacuole. Absent in prokaryotic cells. Only present in eukaryotic cells.

Structure Nuclear envelope Double membrane of nucleus is called nuclear envelope/nuclear membrane Separate the nucleoplasm and cytoplasm. Nuclear pores Pores present in the nuclear envelope are called nuclear pors. Allow the movement of materials . Nucleolus/ (pleural : nucleoli) Non-membranous organelle.
