Adverse Effects on Phenytion. (INCP) oblems with warking and coordination, slurred speech, confusion, dizziness, trouble sleeping, le vousiess, tremor, headache, nausea, vomiting, de supation, and rase.

- Phe won can oral drug the so to treat certain types of seizures.
- Phenytoin can cause serious rashes that may require you to be hospitalized. These rashes may even be fatal.
