The nurse prepares a nursing care plan based on the nursing diagnosis It involves:

- Goals formulation
- Identification of outcomes
- Identification and selection of interventions

Factors to consider when setting priorities

- Clients health values and beliefs
- Client's priorities
- Resources available to the nurse and client
- The urgency of health problem
- Medical treatment plan

4. IMPLEMENTATION

It is the fourth step of the nursing process It is the 'Doing' step

It involves carrying out nursing interventions(orders) selected during the planning step.

It is the final step of the nursing process but is also done concentrate throughout the client's care

It constitutes:

• A comparison of client Selia VI traesponse.

- Unrealistic client outcomes
- Nonspecific interventions
- Inadequate time for the client to achieve outcomes
