# Unlocking the Power of Trigonometric Functions

## SOH CAH TOA

To remember the basic trigonometric functions (sine, cosine, and tangent), use the acronym SOH CAH TOA:

- SOH: Sine = Opposite / Hypotenuse
- CAH: Cosine = Adjacent / Hypotenuse
- TOA: Tangent = Opposite / Adjacent

## Other Functions

The other trigonometric functions (cosecant, secant, and cotangent) are reciprocals of sine, cosine, and tangent:

- Cosecant = 1 / Sine
- Secant = 1 / Cosine
- Cotangent = 1 / Tangent
