Co-operative Societies are managed by people who do not have much capital to contribute and also do not have much education.

The main aim of Co-operative Society is - to uplift the economy + also to provide reasonable std. of living to members

- As they are not managed by professionals the auditors can guide them in managing the societies writing the books etc.

- In All India Level, there is a central Act 1912, based on that each state has made its own state Act.

- Based on the State Act, each society makes the by-laws according to the nature of the society

- Managing committee, Board of Directors who take care of day to day activities.

- Auditor should possess reasonable knowledge in Central Act.
