4. Modal Verbs (Helping Verbs for Different Meanings)

- ✓ **Can** – Ability/Possibility (e.g., I can swim.)
- ✓ **Could** – Past ability (e.g., She could run fast.)
- ✓ **Should** – Advice (e.g., You should study daily.)
- ✓ **Would** – Imaginary situations (e.g., I would travel if I had money.)
- ✓ **Must** – Strong necessity (e.g., You must wear a seatbelt.)
- ✓ **May/Might** – Possibility (e.g., It may rain tomorrow.)

5. Prepositions (Time, Place, and Direction Words)

- ✓ **Prepositions of Time** – in (month, year), on (day), at (specific time).
 - Example: I was born in July, on Monday, at 5 PM.
- ✓ **Prepositions of Place** – in (inside), on (surface), at (specific point).
 - Example: She is in the room, on the chair, at the door.
- ✓ **Prepositions of Direction** – to, from, into, out of.
 - Example: He went to Delhi from Mumbai.

6. Active vs. Passive Voice

- ♦ **Active Voice** – The subject performs the action.
 - Example: She wrote a letter.
- ♦ **Passive Voice** – The action happens to the subject.
