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Golgi Apparatus



Is a large organelle that is usually made up of five to eight cup-shaped, membrane-covered discs called **cisternae**.

1- Break down harmful cell products, waste materials, and cellular debris and then force them out of the cell.

2- They also digest invading organisms such as bacteria.

3- Break down cells that are ready to die, a process called autolysis.

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
