
2) Smooth (involuntary – unstriated) muscles:
They are also called visceral graphin muscles.
They are involuntary & controlled by the autonomic nervous system (ANS). 5
No microscopic striations ⇒ Unstriated.

## 3) Cardiac (involuntary – striated) muscle:

- It is a striated branched muscle. It is involuntary & controlled by the autonomic nervous system (ANS). It is capable of slow & Sustained contractions with <u>no</u> fatigue.
