Asthma: Airways becoming increasingly narrow, attack occurs in stress or fear

Signs- Wheezing, cyanosis

Sympt- Difficulty breathing

Treatment-Salbut. Inhaler, O2

Anaphylaxis: Allergic reaction

Signs- Rash, swelling, gasping, collapse

Sympt- Difficulty breathing, tingling

Treatment- Intra-musc inject, O2, BLS

Epileptic Fit: Disruption of brain activity

Signs- Loss of consciousness

**Tonic Clonic:** 

• Tonic Phase- Rigid

Clonic Phase- Convulsion

Hypoglycaemia/ Diabetic Coma: Diabetics not eating or following insulin taking schedule

Signs- Shaking, cold skin, irritated, slurred speech

## **Treatment:**

- Glucogel if conscious
- Glucagon if unsconscious
- Maintain airway and give O2
