

▼ Plasma Membrane

- Provides entry to some molecules and ions

▼ Semi Permeable Regulator

- Protects and covers the cell
- Regulates what comes in and what goes out
- Communicates with other cellular structures
- Contains flags on surface to help identify friendly and foreign cells

▼ Lipid

- Acts as barrier for polar substances

▼ Plasma Membrane Proteins:

▼ Integral Ion Channel

allows integral ions through the pore

▼ Integral Carrier

- Contains specific substances which change shape once its carried across the plasma membrane

▼ Integral Receptor

- Ions or molecules containing a functional group are recognised and changes the function of the cell

▼ Integral and Peripheral Enzymes

- Increases reaction of site inside and outside of the cell

▼ IAP Linker

- Acts as anchor for filaments
- Provides structural stability
