BONY ATTACHMENTS OF SHOULDER.

A. CLAVICLE

- 1. Lateral End: -Attachment to joint capsule of Acromioclavicular joint.
- 2. Medial End: -Attachment to joint capsule of Sternoclavicular joint.
- 3. Lateral End (one-third Of shaft): -Deltoid muscle origin from anterior border.
 - -Trapezius muscle insertion in posterior border.
 - -Conoid and trapezoid parts of Coracoclavicular ligament from conoid tubercle and trapezoid ridge.
- 4. Medial End (two-thirds of shaft): -Pectoralis muscle origin from anterior part.
- -Sternocleidomastoid muscle (clavicluar head) origin from superior surface.
 - -Costoclavicular ligament from oval impression on inferior la face.
- -Subclavius muscle insertion on subclavian grice of inferior -Sternohyoid muscle originary posterior surface.

B. SCAPI

- 1. Costal Aspect: -Subscapularis muscle origin from medial 2/3rd of subscapular fossa.
 - -Serratus Anterior muscle insertion on medial border.
- 2. Dorsal Aspect: -Supraspinatus muscle origin from medial 2/3rd of supraspinatus fossa.
 - -Infraspinatus muscle origin from medial 2/3rd of infraspinatus fossa.
 - -Teres Minor muscle origin from upper 2/3rd of lateral border.
 - -Teres Major muscle origin from lower 1/3rd of lateral border.
 - -Latissimus Dorsi muscle origin from inferior angle.
- -Levator Scapulae muscle insertion along medial border from superior angle to root of spine.
