Fat Pad Sign - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -radiographic finding that can indicate an underlying injury or fracture in the elbow joint, specifically around the olecranon process of the ulna bone.

McMurray Test - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Palpable or auditory click while rotating and extending the knee

Gout - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Acute joint pain with swelling, warmth, and erythema begins abruptly and involves a single joint. Normal uric acid levels are common during acute attack.

Fundal Height - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Distance from the pubic bone to the top of the uterus in centimeters. After 24 weeks fundal height should equal the number of weeks the patient has been pregnant. i.e. 24cm = 24wks

Asthma - Severe Persistent - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Continuous symptoms, frequent nocturnal symptoms, <60% FEV

Asthma Diagnostic - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Spirometry, Pulmonary Function Tests (PFTs), Allergy Testing, Peak Flow

COPD - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Progressive pathological changes to the airway and/or alveoli due to increased inflammatory response to pollutants or inhaled irritants

COPD Diagnostics - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Gold Standard - Spirometry with bronchodilation.

Other criteria - Prolonged expiratory phase. where in with forced exhalation, barrel chest & tripod population in late phase.

Emproprie Contaminated lymph fluid into the pleural space.

S&S - Cyanosis, pleural pain, fever, tachycardia

Pleural Effusion - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Presence of fluid in the pleural space from blood or lymphatic vessels.

S&S - Dyspnea, atelectasis, pleural pain. Dullness on percussion, mediastinal shift.

Treatment of Mycoplasma Pneumoniae "Walking PNA" - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - Infants - Amoxicillin

School age - Amoxicillin or Macrolide

Croup Treatment - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Racemic Epinephrine, Corticosteroids, Cool-Mist Humidification

** DO NOT USE TONGUE DEPRESSORS, CAN CAUSE SPASM!!

Chlamydia - CORRECT ANSWERS - Most Common STI in US.

S&S - Genital Ulceration, Lymphadenopathy, Occular Trachoma, Proctitis, Cervical Motion Tenderness, Assymptomatic. Can cause PID

Chlamydia Diagnostic & Treatment - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Gold Standard -Nuclieic Acid Amplification Test (NAAT) & Gen-Probe Assay

Tx: Azithromycin in pregnant patients, Amoxicillin if allergic.
Gonorrhea - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - Compton Vite Chlamydia.
S&S - Purulent discharge, pool-tinged discharge, prostatitis
Tx: Ceftrizzone 500mg IMxz, the clamydia also suspected give Doxytycine 100mg BIDx7 days

Bacterial Vaginosis - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Not an STI. Common sexually active females.

S&S - Fishy smell, watery discharge, clue cells, increased alkalosis

Tx: metronidazole (Flagyl), Lactobacillus Probiotics

Genital Herpes - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Herpes Simplex Virus Type 1 or 2, transmitted with direct contact with active lesions or with virus containing fluid.

Tx: Antivirals - Acyclovir, Valacyclovir, Famciclovir. Pt can be infectious while shedding virus.

Assessment of a 4yr old visual acuity results in 20/30 in L eye and 20/40 in R eye - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Means vision is normal for his age. Children at 6 years can normally achieve 20/20 vision.

Medication given for Benign Paroxysmal Positional Vertigo - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Meclizine (Antivert)

Pterygium - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -A growth of fleshy tissue on the conjunctiva that can extend onto the cornea.

- Sx include redness, irritation, and a gritty or foreign body sensation in the eye

Eye Emergencies - *CORRECT ANSWER* Fapilledema •r/t Increased ICP, Swollen Optic Disc, and Engorged Tortoous Vein Acute Closed Angle Glamon C Sadden onset severe eye pain and Rapid loss of vision

Foreign Object in Eye - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Only attempt to remove with wet cotton swab and if not able send to ophthamologist stat

Meniere's Disease - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Vertigo, Tinitus, and Pressure in the Right Ear

Hyperopia (Farsightedness) - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Light that is focused behind the retina causes the visual disturbance

Gonorrhea & Chlamydia treatment - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Doxycycline 100mg BIDx14 days & Ceftriaxone x1 IM

Migraine Treatment - CORRECT ANSWERS -Rescue: Triptans

Prophylactic: Beta Blockers, antidepressants, anticonvulsants (Topamax, Propranolol, Inderal)

Migraine Presentation - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -S&S: Unilateral 70% of time, Crescendo, Nausea/Vomiting, Photophobia, and Auras, Duration: 4-72hrs

Patient Appearance: Pt desires a cool, quiet, dark room Cluster Headache Presentation - *CONECOLOMERS* -Always unilateral, begins around temple/eye, pathpeaks within minutes; excruciating/exploring, thinorrhea, toats, eye becomes red ETOIP can be a trigger

Tension Headache Presentation - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Bilateral, pressure, tightness, band-like, waxes and wanes

Parkinson's Disease - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Deficiency of Dopamine and destruction of cells in the substantia nigra

Parkinson's Disease Presentation - *CORRECT ANSWERS* -Bradykinesia, rigidity, resting tremor ("pill rolling"), postural instability
