A nurse is assisting with the care of a client who has frostbite on both legs after prolonged exposure to outdoor temperatures around 12.2 degrees C (10 degrees F). Which of the following actions should the nurse plan to take? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - Elevate the lower extremities.

A nurse is reviewing the prescriptions for a client who had total hip arthroplasty. Which of the following prescriptions should the nurse verify with the provider? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - Instruct the client to restrict flexion at the hip past 120 degrees.

A nurse is collecting data on a client who has major burn injury. The nurse should recognize which of the following findings as a priority? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - The client produces black colored sputum.

A nurse is caring for a client who has a new cast in place for a fractured tibia. The nurse should recognize that which of the following interventions is a priority? - *CORRECT ANSWERS* - Check for capillary refill distal to the client's cast
